## Hotel Accommodations

PMAAA board member Rick Peter Martin '76 is making arrangements for a block of rooms with the Andrew Hotel in Queens (near the Immaculate Conception Center - about a 15 minute drive). **The Andrew is located at 75 North Station Plaza, Great Neck, NY. Their reply (below) to Ricky explains their policy and rates:

Hello Mr. Martin,

Thank you so much for your interest in **The Andrew Hotel!** I have included some general information about blocking rooms.

I will start out with some information on our group policy, so you may have an idea of the difference of blocking rooms and reserving rates such as the ones you viewed on our website. Our group rates will ultimately be better than any discounts offered online or through the hotel directly.

Our group policy is we initially block 10 rooms max. If you go under 10 rooms there is no financial obligation to you. If you think you need more than 10 rooms we would only add the rooms in increments of 5 once the first 10 rooms are booked; and that would be based on availability of the hotel and would not guarantee you the same rate. These terms and conditions are based on a one month cut-off date prior to the arrival. At that point whatever rooms are not picked up would automatically be released and back into our system to be sold at general sale. This means I could not guarantee your group rate or even availability if that date has come and gone. If you would like to block more than 10 rooms, we would require a credit card guarantee for one night's room and tax of up to half the amount of rooms you block. For Friday November 4, 2016 & Saturday November 5, 2016 I can extend a group rate to you of **\$179.00 per night, per room, not including applicable taxes, presently at 11.625%.**

Our rates include a deluxe continental breakfast in the morning for all our guests which is inclusive in the rate. The hotel is valet parking only, there is a fee of \$13.00 per day, plus tax. Metered street parking is at the guest's own risk.

We do not provide transportation, though I do work with local transportation companies that do have 14 passenger vans or larger.

Please keep in mind that these are rates that are quoted now and can change at any time as our occupancy increases.
